

West African Craton Conference

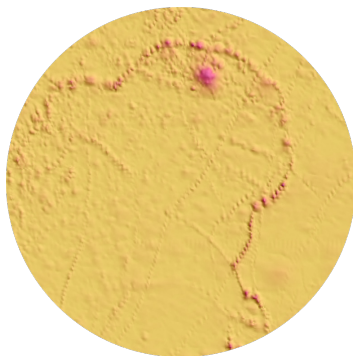
